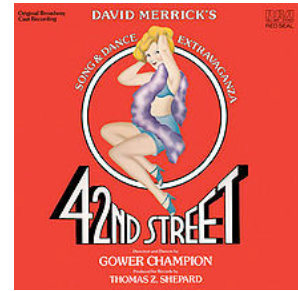


42nd Street
